Rotary Hospice Stratford Perth is a “home away from home” for those who are unable to or do not wish to remain at home with a life limiting illness.

Located behind Greenwood Court in Stratford, our hospice home provides 24-hour specialized palliative care as well as support for those in their life circle, at no cost to the resident.

Why Hike?

Ongoing fundraising is required to ensure that the residents of Perth County receive the care and support they require in the face of illness, death and grief. Unlike hospitals, the Ministry of Health only funds a portion of the costs required to operate a residential hospice. Therefore, our Hospice is responsible for raising over \$950,000 annually to cover operational costs such as non-nursing staff, facility maintenance and supplies, resident meals, volunteer training, and community outreach activity.

100% of funds raised from Hike for Hospice stay in Perth County!

Every year people across Canada gather pledges and hike to raise public awareness for hospice palliative care in their community. Thanks to your support this major fundraising initiative will help advance the hospice palliative care initiatives right here in Perth County.
